MINISTER'S ORDER

ORDER for Increasing Weight Designation on Provincial Highway No. 44.

Reference: Increasing weight limits on 2 sections of Provincial Highway No. 44 in the vicinity of Mantario

Pursuant to section 35.1 of *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997*, the Minister hereby Orders:

For the purpose of managing traffic on and protecting provincial highways, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that effective 12:01 AM, August 28, 2014 unless restricted by a Minister's Order issued pursuant to *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997*, this Order authorizes any person, vehicle or class of vehicles to operate at the weights set for primary highways by *The Vehicle Weight and Dimension Regulations, 2010*, on Provincial Highway No. 44:

i) from the junction with the municipal road allowance located northerly of the NE Section 24, Township 26, Range 27, West of the 3rd Meridian to the junction with the municipal road allowance located northerly of the NW Section 23, Township 26, Range 27, West of the 3rd Meridian; and

ii) from the junction with the municipal road allowance located easterly of Section 31, Township 26, Range 27, West of the 3rd Meridian to the junction with the surveyed municipal road located near the midpoint of the NE Section 36, Township 26, Range 28, West of the 3rd Meridian;

with the exception of April, May, and June of each year.

This Order will remain in effect until **March 31, 2017** unless sooner varied or rescinded.
