## MINISTER'S ORDER

No: 46-2016-WI1

### ORDER for Increasing Weight Designation on Provincial Highway No. 46.

**Reference:** Increasing weight limits to 63,500 kg on Provincial Highway No. 46 from its junction with Provincial Highway No. 1 west to the city limits of the City of Regina.

See Appendix E of *The Vehicle Weights and Dimension Regulations, 2010* for a complete list of Provincial Highways or Portions of Provincial Highways on which B-trains can operate at 63,500 kg. The Ministry of Highways and Infrastructure will include Provincial Highway No.46 as referenced to Appendix E in the next revision of the regulation.

Pursuant to section 35.1 of *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997*, the Minister hereby Orders;

**For the purpose of managing traffic on and protecting provincial highways, NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that effective 12:01 AM, April 8, 2016 unless restricted by a Minister's Order issued pursuant to *The Highways and Transportation Act, 1997*, this Order authorizes any B-train class of vehicle to operate at the weight of 63,500 kg as set out in Section 18 (4) of *The Vehicle Weights and Dimension Regulations, 2010*, on Provincial Highway No. 46 from its junction with Provincial Highway No. 1 west to the city limits of the City of Regina.**

This Order will remain in effect until April 8, 2018 unless sooner varied or rescinded.
